LA FERMETTE TERMS AND GENERAL CONDITIONS

Prices quoted do not include travel from the U.K. Ask for details from the 'Chez Nous' Travel Service (Tel. 01484 684075) for competitive prices on ferry crossings and EuropAssistance car insurance. Recommended ferry routes Portsmouth/St. Malo or Plymouth/Roscoff. We are approximately 1 ¼ hrs. from Roscoff and 1 ¾ hrs. from St. Malo. At the time of writing a discount of 10% on ferry crossings is available from Brittany Ferries when quoting reference F7K609 as a guest of a member of their Property Owners' Club. Useful web sites include www.brittanyferries.co.uk, www.condorferries.co.uk, www.LDLines.co.uk.

Telephone bookings will be held for 7 days pending receipt of the Booking Form and non-refundable deposit of £100 per week booked. All cheques in £ sterling payable to Mrs. S.Taylor, Porz an Caz, 22110 Glomel, France.

The balance of reservations is due 8 weeks prior to arrival, or full amount if booked less than 8 weeks from arrival date. Your balance will be acknowledged and directions to Glomel/Porz an Caz from your chosen ferry port will be sent. At this point your £200 refundable security deposit is also now due ON A SEPARATE CHEQUE PLEASE, made payable to Mrs. S. Taylor and dated 14 days prior to arrival.

Change over day is Sunday unless otherwise arranged – arrival after 2 p.m., departure before 10 a.m. If these timings are not convenient, please let us know and we will do our best to accommodate you. Please do not arrive earlier than 2 p.m. under any circumstances unless you have made arrangements in advance.

Our prices do not include any personal insurance for you and your party, so please do ensure before you arrive that you are fully covered for travel cancellation, accidents, ill health, personal liability etc. Please ensure you have obtained your 'European Health Insurance Card.' You will be covered as a citizen of a European country, depending on the type of medical emergency, for between 60-100% of essential medical treatment while in France. Please note that it is usual in France when receiving outpatient treatment to pay for the treatment and subsequently claim back the proportion you are entitled to. Ask for details from 'Chez Nous' Travel Service (Tel.no.above) In the unlikely event that we have to cancel your holiday (due to fire, flood or other circumstances beyond our control), our liability is limited to a complete refund of your rental fee.

Electricity, Water, Duvets, English sized pillows, bed linen, tea towels and hand towels are provided, but **NOT bath, pool and beach towels.** Towels from La Fermette must not be used by the poolside or taken to the beach. During the summer months a wheelbarrow of wood is supplied, at other times a small charge is made for unlimited wood.

Your holiday home will be clean and fully equipped on arrival, and we ask that you leave it in a clean and orderly condition. Payment for any breakages and damage will be deducted from the security fee, as will any excessive cleaning charges should they be found necessary.

Please note that smoking is not allowed inside any of the buildings.

If you wish to receive post the address is Porz an Caz, 22110 Glomel, France. Please ensure that letters are addressed C/o Taylor/Smith. This is because there are no house numbers at Porz an Caz, the postman knows the names and delivers accordingly. The postbox is at the entrance to the drive and a key hangs in the house. If you wish to use the telephone please make arrangements with us in advance. Your telephone charges will be taken out of your security deposit.

For Insurance reasons, all children must be under the supervision of an adult when using the swimming pool, trampoline, climbing frame and other leisure facilities at Kerdeven. There is safety fencing around the pool and the catch on the gate is out of reach of small children. Please do not allow your children into the pool area unless you are with them. All children are the responsibility of their parents at all times when on site either at La Fermette or Kerdeven. The barn and outbuildings at La Fermette are kept locked and keys are provided for access to the utility area and for firewood. Children must not be allowed to play in these areas or enter unsupervised.

Please remember that many shops and petrol stations are closed on Sundays. A few open on Sunday mornings, this is more likely near port areas. At La Fermette cupboards are stocked with everyday items such as salt, pepper, tea, sugar, herbs and spices++++ etc. We will leave you milk, fruit juice, a bottle of wine, bread and butter (and loo rolls). There is a small supermarket about half an hour away that opens on Sunday mornings, and a 'mini market in Glomel (1.5 miles) which opens on Sundays from 8 until 1 p.m. After 7.00 p.m. and on Sundays it is wise to ensure your petrol tank is full before leaving the port area or motorway (payage) where there are 24 hour service areas. At present, although there is a good road network, there are no 'payage' roads with 24 hour service areas in Brittany. The ports of St. Malo and Roscoff are only about 90 miles, but if travelling from further north it is wise to fill your tank before leaving the Caen area if travelling after 7.00 p.m. or on Sundays.
